FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2021

First Holy Communion will be celebrated in St Patrick's Church Mortlake this year at two 10:30am Sunday morning Masses.

The first is scheduled for **30th May** and the second on the following Sunday **6th June** also at **10:30am**. Candidates will need to have been Baptised and have received the Sacrament of Reconciliation to participate.

There will be four weeks of compulsory instruction to prepare the candidates which will commence on Monday 3rd May in the parish hall in Gale St Mortlake. Subsequent lessons will occur on the following Mondays on the 10th, 17th and 24th May.
