STEWARDSHIP MINISTRY

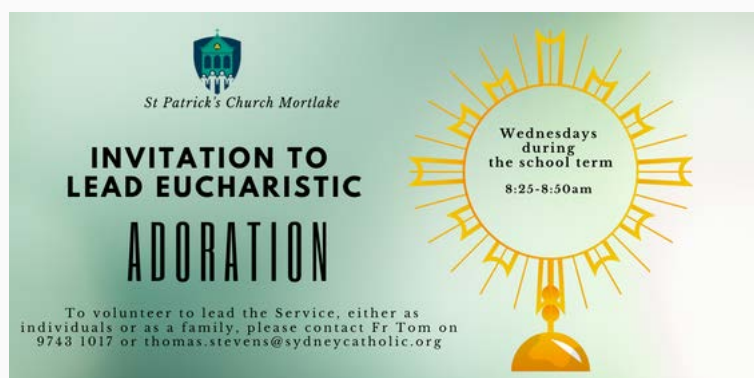
